I have an Invoice model with an attributes :invoices\_group\_ids and :customer\_id I want to test if the right customer is associated to the right invoice. The idea is to create an invoice, create a group and associate a customer to it. The test fails because I do not associate the invoice to the group. I tried this : it "associates a customer to an invoice" do invoice = build(:invoice, :customer\_id => @customer.id) @invoice.invoices\_group\_ids @customer.id.invoice.save! expect(@invoice.reload.invoices\_group\_ids).to eq [Group.create(:customer\_id => @customer.id).id] end Any idea on how to associate the invoice to the group? Thanks A: You are currently setting the invoices\_group\_ids on the invoice, but you need to do it on the group: Group.create(:customer\_id => @customer.id).invoice.associate(invoice) Note that you need to set the customer\_id on the invoice or else the association won't work, so you need to add that attribute before you save.
